to KVCC and did research at their Wind Energy Lab/Library and conferred with Tom Sutton the Director about the standards for siting wind turbines; so that he would be able to defend in court the reasonableness of our ordinance. He provided an example of an environmental impact statement from Santa Barbara, California. He said a United States Court would probably use standards from the US, not European

Standards to compare to our ordinance.

Again there was much public comment about sound. Nathan Steffen a resident offered to do a sound test at our next meeting, as his job is in this area, and he has a decibel meter. The commission agreed to listen. Our next meeting is April 12, 2010, at 7:00 P.M., at the Township Hall.
